WHO CAN REGISTER AS A DOCENT

If you have not been a participant in the docent program before or if it has been more than two years since your last participation, you need to arrange for docent training. Training must be scheduled in advance and will require a minimum of a (5) day commitment. **The 5 days will be spent primarily in classroom training.** You will be expected to have a good knowledge of the book "*Ticket to Toltec*", the *Friends walking tour brochure*, and other resources as necessary. You need to be a person who really enjoys working with people and taking responsibility for solving problems that may arise. However, during the scheduled June and August work sessions, docents may sign-up for the Friends work session lunches using the work session registration process by registering for job #233 (Form R-2) and paying a \$25.00 fee for each week.
